The immunization record must show that the student has met the minimum state requirement: **\*KG (NEW for 2012)** - if the 4<sup>th</sup> dose of polio vaccine is administered prior to the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday, a 5<sup>th</sup> dose of polio vaccine is required for entry into kindergarten. The final dose of the polio series should be administered on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday regardless of the number of previous doses.

**Pre-kindergarten**

**Varicella** (chicken pox) vaccine or date of disease (year) as verified by parent or physician  
3 doses **Hepatitis B**  
4 doses **Hib**  
Up to date for age for **DTaP, Polio, and MMR**

**Kindergarten**

5 doses **DPT** (diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus)  
3-5 doses **\*Polio** (NEW for Kindergarten 2012)  
2 doses **MMR** (measles, mumps, rubella)  
3 doses **Hepatitis B**  
2 doses **Varicella** (Chickenpox) or have had the disease

<b><u>1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade students</u></b>	5 doses <b>DPT</b> (diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus) 4 doses <b>Polio</b> 2 doses <b>MMR</b> (measles, mumps, rubella) 3 doses <b>Hepatitis B</b> 2 doses <b>Varicella</b> (Chickenpox) or have had the disease
